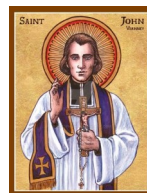

REGISTRATION FOR SUNDAY MASS: Due to capacity restrictions in our church buildings to ensure safe social distancing, booking a place at a Sunday Mass is absolutely essential. **Please book before Friday 3.00pm**. Provide your details (i.e. name, number of places, which Mass required and your phone number) by texting **07903 731 213** (or leaving a voicemail). **If requested before 3pm on Friday, you can assume you are booked in and we will only reply to your text or voicemail if we cannot accommodate you.** Please only book for Masses one week in advance.

BAPTISM: For parents/guardians seeking to have their child baptised, it is essential that you first speak with either Fr Dennis or Fr Henry after mass, during the week or on a weekend. Please book your space at mass if attending on a weekend. There is quite a backlog of baptisms at the moment, and the earliest date for a baptism is late September. Unfortunately, because of covid restrictions we aren't currently able to run a Parish baptism course, so for now we are meeting individually with both parents (child welcome too!), typically on two occasions, usually immediately after Mass.
